SAG Notes:

Try to keep between 15 to 30 minutes between drivers.

Drive back and forth on you route during the time you are assigned to the route.

Do not pass riders if you do not have good sight lines for oncoming traffic.

Check with all riders that are stopped.

Watch riders in your rear view mirror as you pass to see if they signal for help.

Move to the next route at the times indicated.

Stop at rest/food stops for short breaks and to see if there is someone that needs help.

Take lunch break as indicated.

Provide Net Control with the names of people you transport to the start.

Sweep Notes:

Notify Course Monitors when all riders have passed them.

Notify the rest stop HAM and Captain when all riders have arrived. Keep the stop HAM informed as to the number of riders enroute to the stop.

Once the route is clear, move on to your next assignment.

Pick up ride signs and large orange signs once all riders have passed them. Refer to the map provided for the position of orange signs.

Separate metal supports from road signs.

Put signs on the truck at the Lunch Stop or at the end of the ride no later than 5:30 pm.
